When the school donation (which is tax deductible) is paid in full at any time within the current calendar year all extra-curricular fees that have been paid during the year will be rebated to match the fees charged to parents who pay the school donation.

Please note that if the school donation has not been paid and no arrangement has been made to pay it during this year by instalments, students taking part in most activities in our extra-curricular programme will be charged the activity fees (some indicative at this stage) as illustrated.

If the activity fee has not been paid by the Queen's Birthday weekend (Monday 5 June 2017) students will be unable to continue participation in their chosen activity until they are paid and please note these fees can also be paid by instalment, during this year, by arrangement with our accounts department.

The school will also consider any request for assistance paying these fees due to financial hardship.
