



## Applying for entrance to New Zealand Universities

If you are applying for halls of residence at any NZ university you will need to apply online and collect an application form for a CCRF (Common Confidential Reference) from Careers after Aug 1. Applications close on Sept 15. Make sure that you put the name of the university and hall(s) that you are applying to. You do not need a testimonial or academic transcript for this application.

There will be a meeting about these applications early in Term 3.

### TERTIARY APPLICATION CLOSING DATES

You should be thinking about your applications for courses at university, polytechnics and private providers **now**.

- Some are accepting applications already, many open soon.
- Closing dates **vary**.
- Some applications close in August or September.
- Many close in November or December.
- Carefully **check** the provider's **website** and the particular **faculty** for the **closing date(s)** for the course(s) **you** are applying for.

- Check if there are **additional requirements** to complete your application: e.g.
  - Portfolio
  - Audition
  - References
  - Interview
  - Written application
  - Essay
  - CV
- Unless the closing date is earlier we recommend that you **complete your applications by the end of Term 3** before your exams.
