## Homework

### **RATIONALE:**

Homework is an integral part of the student leaving programme at Macleans College.

### **PURPOSE:**

To ensure that homework is set and checked and that homework topics are a meaningful component of a student's learning programme.

### **GUIDELINES:**

- 1 As a general rule, Year 9 and 10 students will received 1 to 1½ hours of homework each night for 4 of the 5 days in a week; Years 11,12 and 13 students can expect 2 to 3 hours per night, across a range of subjects.
- 2 Homework is to be relevant to a student's learning programme and is to be checked regularly.
- 3 Year 13 students are expected to be self sufficient in their homework completion requirements.
- 4 Where appropriate, comments about homework are to appear on a student report.
- 5 It is the responsibility of the Faculty Head to ensure classroom teachers fulfil all homework requirements.
