School Uniform and Grooming

RATIONALE:

The wearing of the school uniform is compulsory for all students.

PURPOSE:

To ensure that the school uniform is worn correctly and that all students are well groomed.

GUIDELINES:

- 1 The school uniform is detailed in the prospectus.
- 2 On enrolment, students and parents/guardians sign that they will abide by and uphold the values, rules and guiding principles of the school as detailed in the prospectus.
- 3 The uniform is to be worn by all students while at school, to and from school and on any activity run by the school where this is a requirement.
- 4 Students not in the correct uniform are required to have a note from home explaining the reason for the discrepancy and the note is to be handed to the house leader for approval no later than 9.00 am on the day concerned.
- 5 The prospectus also details matters pertaining to general grooming such as hair, makeup and jewellery.

Note: Students are also required to wear the correct co-curricular and/or representative uniform as required. The same conditions apply as for the general school uniform

- 6 It is the responsibility of the house leader to ensure form teachers enforce uniform regulations.
