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Review Process

RATIONALE:

The Macleans College Board of Trustees recognises that processes and structures must be in place to review the effectiveness of planning and decision making.

PURPOSES:

- 1 To subject the school's processes and structures to regular critical review.
- 2 To use the feedback from these reviews to improve planning and decision making processes and structures.

GUIDELINES:

- 1 The Senior Management Team survey of staff and board members regularly measure:
 - a) Understanding of the planning and decision making processes for the school.
 - b) The degree to which the planning and decision making committees have satisfied the needs of the staff and Board of Trustees.
- 2 Survey results will be communicated to staff and the Board of Trustees.
- 3 The Board of Studies will carry out a self-review annually to determine the extent to which its activities have contributed to the overall quality goals of this school.
- 4 Each committee will carry out a self-review annually to evaluate the extent to which it has met its objectives. Results of these will be communicated to the Board of Studies.

COMMITMENT:

The Macleans College Board of Trustees will have review processes in place to achieve the quality goals of the school.
