## Court Orders

### **RATIONALE:**

That court orders are adhered to by the school.

### **PURPOSE:**

That the student's well-being and safety is paramount.

### **GUIDELINES:**

1. Information regarding court orders is treated as highly confidential.
2. Details of court orders are to be stored either as a paper copy or electronically in a highly secure place.
3. Decisions regarding a student's well-being and safety are to be referred to and made by the senior management team, including parent or guardian access.
4. Senior management team must confirm court orders by seeking appropriate legal advice before taking action.
5. In reference to point 4., if a parent with a court order against them (particularly child access) appears on the school property without notice, under no circumstances are they allowed access to the child.
