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Extra-Curricular Activity

RATIONALE:

The College has as a guiding principle, the belief in the importance of Extra-Curricular activity. Extra-Curricular activity is seen as an integral part of a young person's personal development. It greatly assists students in gaining confidence, building self esteem, gaining recognition and making use of leisure time. Involvement also engenders loyalty and a strong sense of belonging. The key is participation, commitment and the idea of the all-rounder.

PROCEDURES:

- 1 Students are encouraged to achieve a balance of sporting, cultural and service activities. As a minimum the school expects all students to commit themselves to at least one major activity beyond the classroom.
- 2 Staff must also participate in the Extra-Curricular programme of the school, as agreed with the Principal.
- 3 In order to manage the programme, activities are controlled by a code head. The code head controls his or her managers and coaches and oversees the budget for his or her activity.
- 4 The Extra-Curricular committee acts in an advisory role. It meets to settle any disputes that arise, particularly in the area of Extra-Curricular conflicts.
