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TITLE: **EXTRA-CURRICULAR POLICIES**

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Code of Conduct in Extra-Curricular

RATIONALE:

Most students get involved in Extra-Curricular activities because they enjoy them. It makes them feel good and healthy and it provides them with a social life. It also provides recognition and offers leadership opportunities. Most coaches managers and referees are involved for similar reasons. Extra-Curricular activities encourage co-operation, self discipline and excellence. They also require those involved to abide with the rules of the activity and controlling body.

PROCEDURES:

- 1 The school adheres to the Fair Play Code of Behavior in sport and to the Hillary Commission School Sports Charter.
- 2 The school adheres to the Auckland Secondary Schools Heads Association (ASSHA) Code of Conduct.
- 3 Students are expected to turn up to practices, meeting and fixtures as detailed to the students at the start of their season.
- 4 The school gives recognition to student participation and performance through acknowledgement in house assemblies, school assemblies, on the website, an annual extra-curricular prizegiving, major school end-of-year prizegivings, and the school magazine.
- 5 Leadership opportunities are provided for students as captains, coaches and managers.
- 6 Coaching for coaching courses are made available to both student and student coaches.
