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TITLE: **EXTRA-CURRICULAR POLICIES**

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Sport

RATIONALE:

The school provides a range of sporting opportunities for students. It aims to cater for students at both the recreational level and at the competitive level.

PURPOSES:

- 1 To provide a wide range of intra-school or house based sporting activities. These are to be held either at lunchtimes, after-school or Saturday mornings. These activities are particularly to provide sport opportunities for those students unable at present to gain a place in a team in the code of their choice.
- 2 To provide, within the constraints of limited resources, the sports sanctioned by the Auckland Secondary Schools Heads Association (ASSHA).
- 3 In each major code to provide a first team.

PROCEDURES:

- 1 The sports department is run by a sports director. The sports director is responsible for appointing staff and community coaches to all teams involved in competitions run by ASSHA. The sports director reports to the Deputy Principal in charge of sport. The sports co-ordinators oversee sports purchases, budgets, entries and results. The sports co-ordinators report to the Deputy Principal in charge of extra-curricular.
- 2 Each sport is controlled by a code head. The code heads liaise directly with both the sports director and sports co-ordinators. The code head is responsible for his or her managers and/or coaches. The responsibility of coaches and managers is detailed in the Extra-Curricular Handbook. This includes fair play and safety requirements.
- 3 In the first teams and in the case of other teams playing Auckland A Grade level, the team that takes the field/court shall be at the discretion of the coach/manager. In the case of all other teams squad members should be rotated from week to week or during the game providing the players have fulfilled the appropriate training and attendance requirements.
