General Principles

RATIONALE

The Macleans College Board of Trustees recognises that levels of government funding for schools such as Macleans are not adequate to satisfactorily maintain and develop a quality educational establishment. For this reason the Board of Trustees wishes to establish a framework of relationships and financial endeavours which will bridge the gap between needs and official funding.

PURPOSES

To establish policies which define Board intent and provide principles in relating to external agencies over funding issues. Also provide controlling policies over commercial activities of the school and to ensure that the best available benefits of commercial and other income accrue to the school.

GUIDELINES

Policies in this section should provide guidance for management in developing and administering relationships and commercial activities

COMMITMENT

The Board recognises the responsibility of both trustees and senior management to maintain and develop the already fine educational record of Macleans College. It recognises that the provision of fine facilities attuned to current and future student needs is a vital component for the ongoing success of the school and its attraction to prospective students.
